Budget Committee
Meeting Minutes, October 18, 2021

1 Budget Committee members present: Chair Ben Drugg, Vice Chair Adam Hopkins, Secretary
2 Allan Bailey, Tyler Bagster, TJ Chasse, Jamie Hummel, Matt Meacham, Steve Obert
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4 Richard HKS Thackston and Richard H. Thackston, III, Board of Selectmen Representative,
5 were unable to attend.
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7 Mr. Drugg called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.
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9 The minutes from the August 31, 2021 and October 4, 2021 meetings were presented. MOTION
10 to approve both sets of minutes, Mr. Bailey, SECOND by Mr. Hopkins. All members voted in
11 favor of the motion.
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13 Kim Chaffee of the Troy Historical Society presented 2022 budget proposals for the Historical
14 Society, the Cheshire Railroad Depot and Kimball Hall.
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16 MOTION to tentatively accept the Troy Historical Society 2022 budget proposal as presented, at
17 \$870, Mr. Hopkins, SECOND by Mr. Meacham. All members voted in favor of the motion.
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19 MOTION to tentatively accept the Railroad Depot 2022 budget proposal in the amount of
20 \$4,275, Mr. Hopkins, SECOND by Mr. Obert. There was a brief discussion among the members
21 and Ms. Chaffee regarding some moving figures on the proposal. All members voted in favor of
22 the motion.
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24 MOTION to tentatively accept the Kimball Hall 2022 budget proposal in the amount of \$6,650,
25 Mr. Hopkins, SECOND by Mr. Obert. All members voted in favor of the motion.
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27 Kyle Smith presented 2022 budget proposals for the Zoning Board of Adjustment, the newly
28 reestablished Troy Conservation Commission, and the Planning Board.
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30 The committee determined some items on the ZBA's proposals required answers from Mr.
31 Richard HKS Thackston, ZBA Chair who was unavailable for this meeting. The committee will
32 revisit this issue when Mr. Thackston can be present.
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34 After discussion of the proposal from the conservation commission, Mr. Hopkins made a
35 MOTION to amend the total request to \$2,556, SECOND by Mr. Drugg, for further discussion.
36 Mr. Hopkins stated his reasoning for the changes. After discussion, all members voted in favor
37 of the motion. MOTION to tentatively accept the conservation commission proposal at the
38 amended amount of \$2,556, Mr. Hopkins, SECOND by Mr. Drugg. All members voted in favor
39 of the motion.
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41 MOTION to tentatively accept the Planning Board 2022 budget proposal in the amount of
42 \$4,828, Mr. Hopkins, SECOND by Mr. Obert. All members voted in favor of the motion.
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44 Mr. Drugg called a brief recess of the meeting at 8:15 p.m.

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46 MOTION to adjourn, Mr. Hopkins, SECOND by Mr. Obert. All members voted in favor of the
47 motion.
