6 **Chairman Chasse called the public hearing to order at 5:04 p.m.**

8 The Pledge of Allegiance was done by everyone in attendance.

10 Chairman Chasse read the date of the upcoming Special Town Meeting, which will take place
11 Thursday, July 20, 2024 at 5 P.M. at the Community Center, and the warrant article for the
12 Special Town Meeting: “to see if the town will vote to ratify the results of the March 13, 2024,
13 annual meeting even though the posting requirements were not met.”

15 **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

16 Ben Drugg asked what would happen should the warrant article be voted down at the Special
17 Town Meeting. Town Administrator Bourgeois replied that he spoke with the Department of
18 Revenue Administration (DRA) and asked that question. DRA indicated the Town would have to
19 try again to ratify the March Town Meeting results. It was agreed that this would be an extreme
20 circumstance that is unlikely to happen.
