

CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR CEMETERY'S MAINTAINED BY THE TOWN OF TROY, NH

These rules are reviewed and updated annually by the Cemetery Commissioners.

1. Cement vaults will be required for all burials. Solid containers will be required for all cremations such as metal or concrete.
2. Three days notice will be required for all burials.
3. You must be a current or past resident of the town of Troy to purchase a grave lot. The cost of a lot is **\$150** per single lot, **\$300** per double lot, four grave lots are **\$600**, cremation lots are **\$300**. Note, however no single lots will be sold, with the exception of cremation lots. Included in the price of the lot is cost of upkeep and general maintenance of the lots. Nonresidents add **\$100** to each of the above fees.
4. All graves will be dug per the sexton, and be accompanied by the proper "Permit to Bury". There will be not more than TWO burials per lot, and at least one must be a cremation. Cremation lots also have a TWO burial limit.
5. Shrubs may be donated in memory of a loved one to the cemetery and will be planted and cared for by the cemetery. It will be planted as near to your lot as possible, but not necessarily in your lot. Final decision will be up to the Cemetery Committee.
6. No artificial flowers are permitted at any time. All flowers must be either planted or in pots, preferably next to the head stone. Flowers and pots must be picked up by October 1st. Pots with no flowers or dead flowers will be picked up daily by the cemetery staff, and deposited in the trash.
7. The Cemetery Committee reserves the right to remove or trim any tree, shrub, or bush it feels has grown out of control.
8. There will be a charge of **\$600** to dig a grave for a full burial and a **\$200** charge for all cremations. **Weekend or Holiday** charges are **\$700** for a full burial and **\$300** for a cremation.
9. Graves will only be dug during the months the cemetery is open. Opening and closing of the cemetery will be totally up to the cemetery committee. Typically open when the ground is thawed and closed when the ground is frozen.
10. Corner markers shall be required with the purchase of a lot at a cost of \$100 and must be flush mount. Only one above ground monument per family lot. Additional markers must be flush mount and shall be limited to one per burial. The only exception will be a military marker.
11. Location of above ground monuments in each lot will be placed at the discretion of the Cemetery Committee. Family wishes will be taken into consideration in the placement of all monuments. Any relocation of monuments will be at the family's expense.
12. It is the right and responsibility of all deed holders to receive a copy of these rules and regulations and to contact the Cemetery Commission in regards to annual updates.
