1 **Call to order**

2 Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at **6:05 p.m.**

3 **Correspondence**

4 An email was sent from Alexis Rudko the Deputy Chief of the New Hampshire Department of  
5 Natural and Cultural Resources, proposing a Memorandum of Agreement. The purpose of the  
6 Memorandum of Agreement is to hand over the maintenance of the Rail Trail from the state to  
7 Troy. A sample of the Memorandum of Agreement was provided, and each member of the  
8 Conservation Commission read over the sample.

9 **New Business**

10 Mr. Kowalczyk from the Monadnock Rail Trail Collaborative presented what he would like to do  
11 with a mile of the Rail Trail that runs from Rockwood Pond into Troy. Unfortunately, the grant that  
12 was given was short by \$3,200 for one hundred twenty tons of gravel and Mr. Kowalczyk asked if  
13 that money could be provided by the town. Chairman Smith let Mr. Kowalczyk know that it will  
14 be gone over and considered and that the Conservation Commission will be in touch the  
15 Monadnock Rail Trail Collaborative.

16 **MOTION** to approve minutes from last meeting March 22, 2022, Chairman Smith, **SECOND** by  
17 Mr. Hopkins. All voted in favor.

18 **Old Business**

19 Chairman Smith has been in communication with Troy's Road Agent, Edward Atkins. Mr. Atkins  
20 let Chairman Smith know that any trash bag may be used for the Earth Day Cleanup, although big  
21 trash such as tires will still need to be figured out. The Butterfly Park was discussed as well, and  
22 the Conservation Commission agrees that that will be a big project.

23 **MOTION** to adjourn the meeting, Chairman Smith, **SECOND** by Mr. Hopkins.

24 All members of the board voted in favor of the motion.

25 The meeting adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
