- 1 Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at **6:47 p.m.**
- 2 The Conservation Commission discussed future plans for the Butterfly Park. They discussed  
3 turning the park into a community garden with ten feet by twenty feet plots to be leased out to  
4 individuals. Chairman Smith suggested posting this idea online to see the reaction the public will  
5 have and to understand more of what the town would like to see. The Conservation Commission  
6 discussed the work that the park will need before any plans go into motion and had discussion of  
7 how plants would be watered if a community garden were created. The Conservation Commission  
8 also discussed creating parking areas. The Commission received the file for the Butterfly Park  
9 property and discussed where the road ended. The discussion of the Butterfly Park will continue  
10 at the next Conservation Commission meeting, May 17, 2022, at 6:00pm, where the Commission  
11 will try to make more progress and what the next steps are for the park.
- 12 **MOTION** to approve minutes from last meeting April 12, 2022, Chairman Smith, **SECOND** by  
13 Mr. Bagster. All members of the Commission voted in favor of this motion.
- 14 Chairman Smith would like to create a trust fund for the Conservation Commission and will  
15 contact the Trustees of the Trust Funds and figure out the next step in creating a trust fund is.
- 16 The Conservation Commission discussed the piece of rail trail that runs a mile from Rockwood  
17 Pond into Troy that the Monadnock Rail Trail Coalition would like to work on. The Commission  
18 would like to help them with this project in every way possible.
- 19 **MOTION** to adjourn the meeting, Chairman Smith, **SECOND** by Mr. Davis.  
20 All members of the commission voted in favor of the motion.
- 21 The meeting adjourned at 7:52 p.m.
