Call to Order

1 Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at **6:06 p.m.**

2 **Correspondence**

3 Chairman Smith read a letter from the Department of Transportation, they will be giving a
4 presentation at the Troy Recreational Center for the bridge work that is being done in town, on
5 June 23, 2022, at 6:30pm.

6 **New Business**

7 **MOTION** to approve minutes from last meeting May 17, 2022, Chairman Smith, **SECOND** by
8 Mr. Davis. All members of the Commission voted in favor of this motion.

9 **Old Business**

10 The Conservation Commission continued discussion on the Butterfly Park. The Commission
11 discussed rototilling the ground at the Butterfly Park. Chairman Smith wants to find out more on
12 how the commission can rent equipment. Mr. Davis suggested that the Conservation Commission
13 post on Facebook asking for a volunteer to till the land.

14 The brook next to the Butterfly Park has a beaver dam that is diverting the water and it will need
15 to be demolished. Mr. Davis explained that the water is low so it would be optimal to do it sooner
16 rather than later. There were questions on whether someone needed to be contacted to get approval
17 to demolish the dam. Since the beaver dam is on the property there should not be an issue with
18 demolishing it.

19 Chairman Smith would like to contact the town administrator and the town treasurer to figure out
20 where the money that the Conservation Commission has come from. To further the trust fund
21 project.

22 There was a large discussion about the town owned properties.

23 **MOTION** to adjourn the meeting, Chairman Smith, **SECOND** by Mr. Hopkins.

24 All members of the commission voted in favor of the motion.
