

**SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES
TOWN OF TROY
SAMUEL E. PAUL COMMUNITY CENTER
Thursday February 18, 2021**

Chairman Thackston called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: There were no public comments addressed to the Board of Selectmen.

REQUEST FOR APPOINTMENT: Joe Sabolevski from Troy Powersports came to the meeting to inquire of the process for approval of construction of a new building on the Troy Powersports property. The Board pointed Mr. Sabolevski to the Planning Board. There will need to be a site plan review by the Planning Board. The Board made Mr. Sabolevski aware of the Planning Board's upcoming meeting schedule.

OLD BUSINESS: The Board reviewed the Town Warrant and the DRA Form MS-737 for posting. There was a correction to the amount of Article 5, Operating Budget as the total in the copy did not reflect the proper amount. A correction of wording to Article 23, New Hampshire Redistricting Resolution, a non-monetary article was made to make the article more understandable to voters. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT: Administrator Guild presented the proof copy of the 2020 Annual Town Report for review. Selectman Hopkins made a correction to the Planning Board membership, adding Tristan Hopkins to the roster and Chairman Thackston added Jennifer Rhodes as State House Representative, Cheshire District 15.

The Board and the Town Administrator discussed the process for running Town Meeting, most of which is up to the Town Moderator and the Town Clerk.

Tax Collector, Marcy Johnson, was invited to the meeting to present the unpaid property taxes. The principal amount due to the Town of Troy for several years is \$166,954.

The Board requested that Administrator Guild project what amount is necessary to run the town until the next property tax warrant is issued in June. The Board requested this information for the next meeting on March 4, 2021.

BOARD OF SELECTMEN REPORTS: Selectman Hopkins announced the Recreation Committee has scheduled Saturday, February 27, 2021 to dismantle the haunted house display on the second floor of Town Hall. Selectman Hopkins also reported the next Community dinner sponsored by the Recreation Committee will be on March 13, 2021 from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. for pick-up, price \$5.00 per plate. The menu is a corned beef and cabbage dinner.

Chairman Thackston reminded the public of the upcoming local elections on March 9, 2021 at the Samuel E. Paul Community Center, beginning at 10:00 a.m. and the Annual Town Meeting on March 10, 2021 commencing at 7:00 p.m. at the Troy Elementary School.

Chairman Thackston announced the next meeting of the Board of Selectmen, March 4, 2021.
